The winning individual is honored at the Walworth County Junior/Senior Leaders' Banquet in the fall. 4-Hers may only win this award once during their 4-H career. Applicants must:

- Have been in grades 6-13 on January 1 of the calendar year in which they are applying.
- Have been enrolled in a variety of Communications, Arts & Crafts, and/or Theater Arts projects during their 4-H career, but must have been enrolled in at least one during the year of application, as well. These projects include: *Art I-II, Block Printing, Ceramics, Clowning, Communications I-III, Creative Writing, Drawing & Painting, Folk Arts, Latino Cultural Arts, Leathercraft, Metal Enameling, Scrapbooking, Speaking, Stenciling, and Theater Arts I-III.*
- Complete a *County-level Requirements 4-H Record Book*.
- Complete this application (either handwritten in ink or typed). Add paper if needed.
- Submit the application and record book to the local club leader by the club's record book deadline. Attach this form to the OUTSIDE FRONT COVER of your 4-H Record Book with a paper clip or binder clip.
