HARVESTERS 4-HCLUB GUIDELINES

MEMBERSHIP

- 3rd grade through one year beyond high school
- Re-enrolling members must register online by November 24th. (This will allow them to be approved by the December 1st deadline.) New members must register on line by February 23rd, (This will allow them to be approved before the March 1st deadline.) Transfer members must have been members in good standing in their previous club. Parent Advisory Board must approve transferring members after the November meeting.
- \$35.00 dues per member payable with enrollment and behavior forms. ****You will need to supply a current e-mail address as most of the communication from the club as well as the county comes via e-mail. If you do not have e-mail we will contact you by phone.
- To re-enroll and maintain membership in GOOD STANDING a member must
 - 1. Follow the Walworth County 4-H behavior agreement
 - RE-ENROLLLING MEMBERS- Attend at least 5 meetings per year. 2.
 - NEW MEMBERS- Attend ½ of the meetings after you join. 3.
 - ****You must be in attendance at 7:15 and remain at the meeting to be counted. 4.
 - ****Participate in at least 2 club activities or community service projects per year (WCF and caroling does not count) One must be a nursing home visit.
 - 6. Carry at least one project
 - 7. Turn in a record at the SEPTEMBER MEETING
 - It must contain a permanent record (PPR)
 - b. It must contain an activity report (MPE-A)
 - It must contain intro page
 - These must be in the green covers provided by the county or in a ring binder with the covers included
 - It MUST be completed in its entirety by the member. ****Completing these will allow you to remain in good standing. To receive any county awards or your clover or date bars, you must complete the entire record book per county award policy guidelines.
 - NO RECORD BOOK, NO PREMIUM CHECK FROM THE WCF
- ****If you ARE NOT IN GOOD STANDING IN Harvesters 4-H, you may enroll the following year but may participate only in club activities. You will not be allowed to do any county activities such as camp, Walworth County Fair.
- ****If you are not in good standing, you may appeal to the Parent Advisory Board to reinstate your good standing status. in the club. If you don't like their decision, you may appeal to the County Executive Board if you would like to remain in the club or join another.
- Entry forms for the Walworth County Fair are due at the MAY meeting. (These may be online as well.)

- 1st and 2nd graders
- \$5.00 dues with enrollment and behavior forms.
- Meetings will be from 6:00-7:00 p.n. before each general meeting. C.
- Must participate in one club or county activity. D.
- Must complete cloverbud record book. E.
- May show at the Walworth County Fair. F.
