Registration Deadline: March 9, 2019 at 5 p.m. (March 9 postmark will be accepted)

Cost: \$150 per camper

Camper registration form and at least \$75 must be turned in to the UW-Extension office to lock in the \$150 rate. The remaining balance must be paid in full by 5 p.m. on May 1 or camper will be unable to attend without refund. Paying the balance off on time is your responsibility. You will not be billed for outstanding amounts. Make checks payable to: *Walworth County Senior Leaders' Association*.



Regular Registration – March 10 - May 1

Regular Registration: March 10 – May 1, 2019 at 5 p.m.

Cost: \$175 per camper

Camper registration form and at least \$87.50 must be turned in to the Walworth County UW-Extension office to constitute camper "registration." The remaining balance must be paid in full by 5 p.m. on May 1 or camper will be unable to attend without refund. Paying the balance off on time is a family responsibility. You will not be billed for outstanding amounts. Make checks payable to: *Walworth County Senior Leaders' Association*. Absolutely no camp registrations will be accepted after May 1.

Refund Policy

No refunds will be given for cancellations received after May 1 unless a medical doctor's order prohibiting camp participation is provided. Until May 1, full refunds can be given.

Chaperone Opportunities

Adults interested in serving as camp chaperones are asked to contact the UW-Extension office at 262-741-4959 or email deborah.moser@ces.uwex.edu to request a chaperone application and be considered for placement. Chaperones must be actively enrolled, 4-H-screened volunteers at the time of camp. If chaperoning interests you, and you are not screened at present, please begin the process immediately. Screening can take time. Chaperones must be at least 21 years of age at the time of camp, and it's recommended that alumni have taken at least two years off between counseling and chaperoning. Chaperones registration fees are covered by the Walworth County Junior & Senior Leaders' Associations. Chaperone positions are limited.
