WHO SHOULD BE A CERTIFIED PRIVATE APPLICATOR?

If you or your employees purchase, mix, or apply "**Restricted Use**" pesticides in Wisconsin, you **MUST** be certified to do so. Certification is valid for 5 years.

PRE-REGISTRATION

- Applicators must sign-up for a class and pick up class textbooks at least one week prior to the class.
- Applicators may register and pay at any UW-Extension Office (Racine, Kenosha or Walworth).
