

Harvesters 4-H Club

MEMBERSHIP

- A. 3rd grade through one year beyond high school
- B. Re-enrolling members must register by November 24th. (This will allow time to be approved by the December 1st deadline.) New members must register by February 23rd. (This will allow time to be approved by the March 1st deadline.)
- C. \$40 per member payable to the club by the January meeting. New members must pay by the March meeting.
- D. to re-enroll and maintain membership in GOOD STANDING a member must
 1. Follow the Walworth County 4-H behavior agreement
 2. RE-ENROLLING MEMBERS- attend at least 5 club meetings per year.
 3. NEW MEMBERS- attend half of the meetings after you join.
 4. ****You must be in attendance at 7:15 and remain at the meeting to be counted as attending.
 5. ****Participate in at least 2 club activities or community service projects per year. (WCF and caroling do not count) One must be a nursing home visit.
 6. Complete at least one project
 7. Turn in a record book at the SEPTEMBER MEETING
 - a. It must in a 3 ring binder with a completed record book cover
 - b. It must contain the current county record book checklist
 - c. it must contain current county intro page with picture
 - d. It must contain a completed permanent participation record (PPR) (4-Hers with a PPR from 2016 or earlier should place their old PPR directly behind their current PPR in their record book.)
 - e. It must contain a minimum of one project area record.
- E. ****If you ARE NOT IN GOOD STANDING in Harvesters 4-H, you may enroll the following year but may only participate in club activities. You will not be allowed to do any county activities such as camp, Walworth County Fair, etc
- F. ****If you are not in good standing, you may appeal to the Parent Advisory Board to reinstate your good standing status. If you do not like their decision, you may appeal to the County Executive Board if you would like to remain in the club or join another.
- G. Online fair entries are due the end of May.

CLOVERBUDS

- A. Kindergarten through second grade
- B. \$40 dues (See above for deadlines)
- C. Meetings will be from 6:00-7:00 before the general meeting.
- D. Must participate in one club or county activity.
- E. Must complete cloverbud record book.
- F. May show at the Walworth County Fair.

CLUB MEETINGS

- A. General meeting- 3rd Monday at the Darien Senior Center for 7:00-8:00 except for June, July and August. These will be announced as we cannot use the center during the summer months.
- B. Exploring/cloverbud meetings- before the general meeting at 6:00.
- C. Community service projects- before the general meeting at 6:00.

D. Project meetings at the discretion of the leader. Each leader is encouraged to have at least 3 meetings.

E. Club and community service activities as they are announced.

ELECTIONS

A. Candidates must be members in good standing.

B. Members may not hold the same office 2 years in a row.

C. Nominations for office by sign-up by the September meeting. Elections will take place at the October meeting with installation at the banquet or November meeting.
