June 17-21 at Burlington High School

This course is open to youth ages 12 to 16

Includes both classroom and hands-on driving instruction, culminating in a final written and driving exam
Meets the requirements of Wisconsin Act 455, which requires youth under the age of 16 to hold a certificate of training in order to operate a tractor on a public road
Meets the child labor requirements under the Fair Labor Standards Act, pertaining to the employment of youth ages 14-15 on farms not operated by their parents or guardians

Cost is \$50 per participant
