Minimum Eligibility Requirements

- Applicant must have a high school graduation date of June of current year or earlier.
- Applicant must have been a Walworth County 4-H Horse & Pony Project member for at least two (2) years.
- Applicant must be enrolled or planning to enroll as an undergraduate in a university, college, or technical school during the upcoming academic year.
- Applicant must have a current grade point average of at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.

Selection Criteria

- Demonstrated personal growth and development through Walworth County 4-H projects and activities.
- Held leadership roles in Walworth County 4-H and other organizations.
- Academic record.
- Sense of direction in future educational goals.

Notification of scholarship awards will be made during the opening ceremony of the 4-H Qualifying Show.

Distribution Procedures

Scholarship awards will be distributed upon completion of the first semester of enrollment at the university, college, or technical school during the upcoming academic year. Prior to receiving their scholarship award, recipients will need to provide:

- A collegiate academic transcript for at least one term showing a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.0 on a 4.0 scale or academic good standing on another scale.
- A copy of current term fee slip or other document that confirms continued enrollment at the university, college, or technical school.

DIRECTIONS – Please follow all directions or your application will not be considered.

- 1. Application for the Walworth County 4-H Horse & Pony Project scholarship must be submitted on the Walworth County 4-H Horse & Pony Project scholarship application form.
 - Applications must be complete or they will not be considered.
 - *Use only the space provided.*
 - Do not attach separate sheets, clippings, etc., except for specific items listed below.
- 2. Attach a copy of your most recent high school transcript and transcripts from all universities, colleges, or technical schools you have attended. Allow your school/s plenty of time to process your transcript request. If your school must send your transcripts directly to the Walworth County Extension Office, please note that on your application. At least one set of transcripts must be official.
- 3. Attach one letter of recommendation to scholarship application submitted.
