To be eligible, you must have been actively involved in the Walworth County poultry, rabbit, or goat project for 3 out of the last 5 years of your 4-H/FFA career and be at least a senior in high school or a college freshman with plans to continue your education at a four-year college or a two-year technical school. You may apply for the scholarship twice, but may only receive the scholarship once.
