

On-line Educational Meeting Options for Walworth County Beef Project Members 2019-2020 Project Year

If you still need credit for attending an educational BEEF meeting to be eligible for fair, Junior Beef Superintendent Doc Sterken is offering you the option to participate in an on-line training to accomplish this.

If you are new to the *Beef Project* (1st, 2nd, or 3rd year), you can view **Season 1 of the Stock-Show U (all episodes)**. If you are a more experienced member (4th year and more), you can view **Season 2 of the Stock-Show U (all episodes)**. Click on the season at the top center once you get to the home page. When you are done with the season appropriate for you, complete the [Beef Project Verification Form](#). Save it to your hard drive. Then, email the saved version to Doc Sterken as directed on the form. **Do this no later than June 1.** Please disregard the bit on the verification form that references attaching handouts, fliers, etc.

You have already met the educational meeting requirement if you signed in at the *2019 Beef Carcass Results* program at last year's fair OR if you attended the December '20 Beef Project Meeting/Pizza Night at the County Government Center. Participation in shows such as the Badger Kick-off Classic also counts, but you must notify Doc about your participation in such experiences in order to get credit, and those shows must be ones you have participated in during this project year.
