Current programming restrictions due to COVID-19

As of Thursday, May 28th, the directive from the University remains as follows...

- All in-person 4-H programming remains canceled through May 31.
- Given the significant amount of planning and the difficulty of maintaining safe operating guidelines, all overnight camps are canceled through August.
- Out-of-state 4-H program travel is also not permitted through August.
- During the month of June (likely in the second half of the month), we hope to begin limited in-person gatherings of up to 10. These meetings and programs will require the Educator/Volunteer to demonstrate both the need for an in-person meeting and a thorough plan for maintaining safety guidelines and will require approval. Virtual meetings remain preferred. If it can be accomplished via distance, it should be.

Additional guidance for programs will be coming soon.

If you have questions about moving forward with a program, clinic, practice, etc. please reach out. We have also been working with different clubs and projects to prepare alternative ways of doing things. If you would like help, please feel free to ask.

New Business: Project Showcase: Ray said the Poultry Project is having zoom meetings, offering programs on you tube and trying yet to figure out how to handle things at the fair. Someone dropped a rooster off at Ray's house, which he has decided to use as a mascot named Gary. Have been working on helping members learn more about the different kinds of birds. Jr. Leaders have been helping younger members; they are having videos on getting things ready for the fair. They are having a t-shirt design contest and trying to get a blog set up for new members to get important information to them.

Club/Group Reports: Elkhorn 4-H has cancelled their 4th of July ice cream social at Sunset Park.

Guidelines are still being set by the state on what we are allowed to do. It will start with 10 members or less with a written program plan that will have to be approved by the county 4-H educator before moving forward through multiple levels of approval.

The county is working on an alternative camp to be held July 23-24. Tim Boss made a motion seconded by Lisa Brockman for the Sr. Leaders to give \$2000 to help pay for supplies and meals, with the participants paying something when more is known about participation and costs. Motion carried. Still waiting for guidelines to see if the Shooting Sports will be able to go forward.

Tim Boss made a motion, seconded by Jennifer Schell, to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried.
