

2020 Walworth County Junior Sheep Show Information

The 2020 Junior Sheep Show is set for Saturday, August 29.

- The show will begin at approximately 10 a.m.
- Weigh-in will run from 7-9 a.m.
- Please plan to bring your fair entry tags for SHEEP to the fairgrounds with you on show day. Make sure you have your market lamb tags in hand to present at the weigh-in scale.
- Exhibitors must complete a *Market Lamb Drug History Form* for every market animal they are bringing to the fairgrounds.
- Park in the Machinery Row area of the fairgrounds.
- Work off your trailers, if possible. If you absolutely need to, you may use pens in the Sheep Barn, but all garbage must be removed before you leave the fairgrounds that day.
- Plan to bring your animals to the fairgrounds show ready. Please don't expect to be clipping or fitting at the fairgrounds.

ALL exhibitors who entered the 2020 Walworth County Junior Sheep Show are asked to reach out to Superintendent Tim Ehlen to confirm what animals you are planning to bring to the show. In order to ensure that the show runs as smoothly as it can, he wants to touch base with everyone--even if you are still planning to bring everything you originally entered. If you have decided NOT to show, you can still put your animal on the "market" trailer on show day. Simply arrive at the fairgrounds by 4 p.m. on August 29 and check-in with Tim or Megan Wieners to have your animal identified and loaded. Animals not present during the show weigh-in time at the fairgrounds will be weighed at Pinn-Oak.

Carcass class lambs should be brought to the fairgrounds Sheep Barn on September 1 from 6-6:30 p.m. to be weighed-in and loaded onto the truck for transport to the locker. All carcass lambs must be accompanied by both a completed *Market Lamb Drug History Form* and a *2020 Buyer Information Sheet* when they are presented at the weigh-in scale. Additionally, please have your fair entry tag for this class in hand. Thank you to Sorg Farm Packing for electing to award a \$200 cash prize for the *Champion Carcass Lamb* and a \$100 cash prize for the reserve!
