- Near the administration building, you will find a wooden sculpture scene called "Chaos in Camp." <u>How many Native Americans</u> are there in the camp?
- 2) Find the Baltic Mill. <u>What year</u> was it built? (Hint: check out the front of the building.)
- 3) How many stone steps are there leading from the Baltic Mill to the Performing Arts Stage?
- 4) Locate the Baltic Mill Performing Arts Stage. On each side, you will find metal statues of musicians. <u>How many total musicians</u> are there?
- 5) Near the Baltic Mill, you will find the Kishwaukee River, and you may be surprised to find "children" playing in the water year-round. <u>How many children</u> are playing in the water?
- 6) Near the stage, you will find a sculpture donated by Jack and Peggy Wolf. <u>What two animals</u> are featured?
- 7) Find the pedestrian swinging bridge; it is so much fun to cross! <u>What is the weight limit</u> on the bridge?
- 8) Find the fishing pavilion sponsored by the Lions Club. <u>What FIVE fish</u> are featured on the "Attention Anglers" sign?
- 9) Find the Whispering Winds shelter. How many posts hold up the building?
- 10) The park has a disc golf course. Find hole #5. <u>Who is the sponsor</u> of that hole? (Hint: located near the large stone grill across the river from the Baltic Mill.)
