- 1) What was your first impression of Yellowstone Lake State Park?
- 2) How big is Yellowstone Lake? How many acres?
- 3) What river sustains Yellowstone Lake?
- 4) Looking at the lake, why do you think it was named Yellowstone Lake?
- 5) What is the name of the 1-mile hiking trail dedicated to observing animals in their natural habitat? (Hint: It goes past the lakeshore and wetlands on the west side of the property near the park office.)
- 6) List *at least* three different signs of animal life that you observed while at the park.
- 7) What kind of trees would you say are *most prevalent* in the park: deciduous or coniferous? (Hint: deciduous trees lose their leaves in the fall; coniferous trees are green year round.)
- 8) Find something in the park with a weird texture. What is it? Why do think it's weird?
- 9) This park is known for its appeal to a large variety of bird species. Describe the largest bird that you observed during your visit. Do you know what kind of bird it was?
