BEFORE THE MEETING

Prepare one or both of the BINGO cards provided in your *February 4-H Family Packet*. To accomplish this, you will need **scissors** and **glue or tape**.

- 1) Cut out images from the sheet accompanying your BINGO card.
- 2) Choose your favorites, and glue or tape one onto each BINGO square. If you are working on both BINGO cards at the same time, be sure that a particular image only appears on each of your BINGO cards once.
- 3) Gather 48 tokens to use as BINGO game card markers and have them on hand for the meeting.

Examples of things you might use include: kernels of popcorn, sunflower seeds in the shell, small building blocks or Legos, pennies or dimes, cereal pieces, dried beans, or M & M's.
