- Tips for anyone considering a similar career

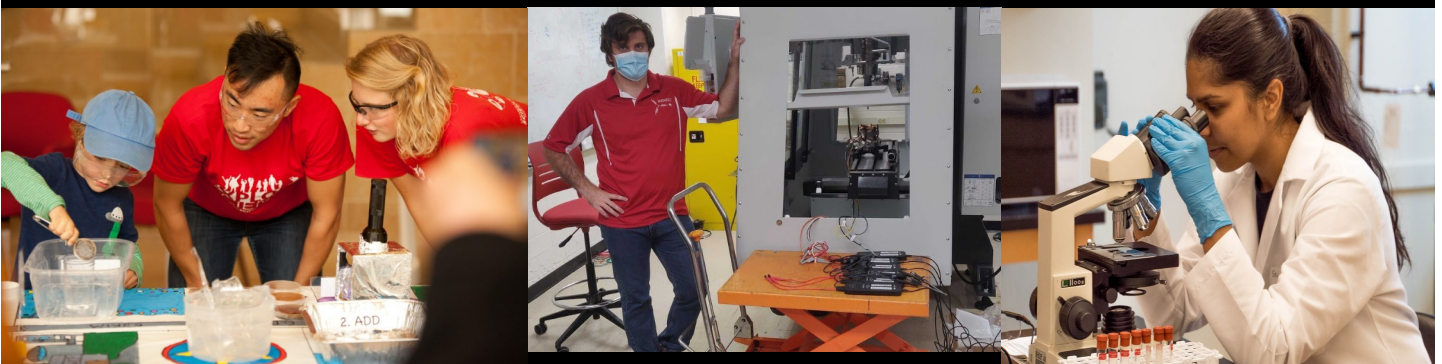
