- Weather permitting, the garden will be open the third Friday in May.
- Tilling will be done prior to the growing season.
- Water will be available on site.
- The University of Wisconsin-Madison Extension Walworth County staff will have programs, demonstrations, and updates to support gardeners throughout the growing season.
- Produce must be harvested and plots cleaned by the fourth Friday in October 2022 (closing date).
