Refund Policy

No refunds will be given for cancellations received after May 20 unless a medical doctor's order prohibiting camp participation is provided. Until May 20, full refunds can be given.

Chaperone Opportunities

Adults interested in serving as camp chaperones should reach out to Debbie Harris at the Extension office to express interest and immediately enroll in 4HOnline as a 4-H volunteer chaperone. Chaperones must be fully screened 4-H adult volunteers with chaperone training at the time of camp. A limited number of positions are available. That said, we do need 2-3 more male chaperones and 2-3 more female chaperones in order to camp this year! Please give this your consideration.

Chaperones must be at least 21 years of age at the time of camp, and it's recommended that alumni have taken at least two years off between counseling and chaperoning. Chaperones' registration fees are covered by the Walworth County Junior & Senior Leaders' Associations.
