



Walworth County 4-H Camp

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Description:

Walworth County 4-H Camp is held each June or July at Upham Woods Outdoor Learning Center in Wisconsin Dells, Wisconsin. This four-day, three night outdoor adventure engages 4-Hers in a wide variety of fun and educational activities designed to build life skills, inspire friendships, and grow amazing memories that will last a lifetime! Camp activities vary a little from year to year, but typically include: archery, canoeing, swimming, hiking, nature science, campfires, arts and crafts, teambuilding, recreation, and much more! 4-H Camp offers members unique opportunities to paddle the Wisconsin River, explore the trails and caves of Blackhawk Island, and meet and learn about camp's resident critters.



Who is Eligible?

4-Hers, grades 3-8, can attend as campers. 4-Hers, grades 9-13 can apply to train and attend as counselors, so long as they will be 15 years old by the start of camp. Options also exist for Counselors-in-Training (grade 9) and adult chaperones (over 21 years old).
