Still Recruiting Chaperones for Camp '23

Walworth County 4-H Camp is set for June 23-26, 2023 at Upham Woods Outdoor Learning Center in the Wisconsin Dells. Counselor and camper applications will be available in December. Currently, we are continuing to seek both male and female adult chaperones for next summer's experience. Chaperones must be at least 21 years of age and fully screened enrolled 4-H volunteers. (Counselor alumni are asked to take at least two years off between counseling and chaperoning.)

We will need approximately 8 male and 7 female female chaperones (plus 4-H Staff) to support our camp group in 2023, and our goal is to identify all team members **by March 1**. Serving as a camp chaperone is fun, rewarding, and a great way to both support youth leaders and grow your adult connections in the program. Chaperones rarely teach at camp. Rather, they spend their days and evenings assisting counselors who are managing cabin groups or leading activities. They also have responsibilities for program set-up, clean-up, snack prep, and overnight cabin supervision.
