Walworth County 4-H Junior Leaders Association Minutes Monday, January 23, 2023

The Junior Leaders meeting was called to order by President Xabier Bisabarro-Hudoc at 7:01 p.m. and pledges were said. The minutes of the last meeting were read by Secretary Eloise Rohloff, moved by Matthew Markham, seconded by Scarlett Klietz, and approved. Treasurer Connor Schell read the treasurer's report. The ending balance was \$19,145.17 in the checking account. The report was moved by Rosemary Markham, seconded by Wade Hartmann, and approved.

The Extension report was given by Debbie Harris. She explained that the camp counselor applications were due on January 31st at 5 p.m. The interviews for camp counselors will be on February 9th from 5-8 p.m. The first training would be on February 23rd. She shared that they are still looking for 4-H Camp chaperones and applications are due by March 1st. There is also going to be two Clover University sessions with at least four workshops each night coming up. The Junior Beef weigh-in is at the fairgrounds on February 4th from 9 am-12 pm. She also mentioned that at the Elkhorn Mini Maker Fair, we would have a booth this year and a sign-up to help was sent around. An icebreaker was led by Judy Rodriguez.

Unfinished Business

During unfinished business, Matthew and Rosemary Markham talked about how they led youth in a project at the New Family Orientation. Wade Hartmann also talked about the December 21st Clover University where they made blankets. The attendees of the Officer Training talked about their experience.

New Business

The motion to purchase thermals was moved by Scarlett Klietz, seconded by Lily Leedle, and passed. The day trips you could take this summer are the Upham Day Trip and the 4-H Science Explorers "Into the Lab" Day trip. The next meeting's icebreaker will be led by Scarlett Klietz and our activity will be DIY Craft Night. We then listened to some club reports.

Scarlett Klietz moved to adjourn the meeting. Eoin Martin made the second. The meeting was adjourned at 7:54 pm. The next meeting date is February 27th at 7 p.m. in the County Government Center. We then did Small Group Olympics which included three different activities led by Caylah Boldt, Eoin Martin, and Judy Rodriguez followed by a snack.
