Monday, March 27, 2023

The ending balance was \$20,438.77 in the checking account. The report was moved by Wyatt Esch, seconded by Eoin Martin, and approved.

The Extension Report was given by Debbie Harris. She mentioned that the House of Pork is looking for new leadership with the upcoming events this year to serve food. Janel is organizing a cultural cooking class. There is also going to be a Clover University session on June 15th. She also talked about the 4-H day camp that will be held on July 20th. Other trips coming up this year are the 4-H Science Explorers Trips and the Upham day trip for prospective camp counselors. There are also two YQCA trainings being planned in the upcoming months for livestock showers.
