## FINANCIAL ACCOUNT AUTHORIZATION

Friendly reminder, it is required that each account have at least two unrelated people authorized on all accounts. Please be sure that your club or group has the two unrelated adults and one youth (optional) on each account.

## ANNUAL FINANCIAL REPORTS (AFR)

4-H Clubs and Groups that have a checking and/or savings account must annually complete and submit the Annual Financial Report and supporting documents to the 4-H Program Educator. This process allows the 4-H Club or Group to qualify for federal tax-exempt status under the University of Wisconsin Board of Regents General Exemption Number (GEN) for Wisconsin 4-H Clubs and Groups. *Please use the folder/organizational system provided—all documents should be returned in the folder that was sent in the mail. **This year all AFRs and supporting documents are due to Janel Heidelmeier by August 15.***

## HOUSE OF PORK LEADERSHIP NEEDED

*Our long time House of Pork chairperson has stepped back. As a result to that the House of Pork is in need of a new chairperson or a group of leaders to oversee its operations.* The Walworth County 4-H House of Pork (HOP) is the largest fundraiser for the Walworth County 4-H program and it is critical that it remains in operation to support the Walworth County 4-H program. The HOP allows both the Junior Leaders and Senior Leaders Associations to financially support a variety of things such as; **educational experiences scholarships, Clover University, 4-H Residential and Day Camp, Cloverbud programming**, etc. The duties of this role could be and is suggested to be divided amongst several individuals with responsibilities divided between the flea markets and fair. One or more individuals are needed to physically run the House of Pork trailer at the four antique flea markets (May 21, June 25, August 13, and September 24) and the six days at the Walworth County Fair (August 30-September 4). Duties include getting the trailer ready before each flea market and fair, running the trailer on the day of the flea market, overseeing the trailer with the in-charge district rep at fair, and shutting down the trailer after each event. The outgoing chairperson and others will provide any assistance needed.
